As a market stallholder, we request that if you or your staff have any relevant criminal convictions relating to child-safety, they be disclosed (any disclosures will be held in the strictest confidence within BGT). BGT/Barkly Square reserve the right to reject a stallholder's application if they feel there is a safety risk to visitors.

Failing to comply with the terms of this agreement may lead to your exclusion from Barkly Square.
